Instructors

The Brush & Palette's professional staff includes several local artists with well-established reputations. Pam Talley, Nina Allen Freeman and Charlotte Forehand have been associated with the studio for many years. Our summer program is led by Natalie Cox and Leah Kennett, both of whom teach art in the Leon County School System. Well-known Russian artist Natalia Andreeva will be joining our staff along with Olivia Samper who will be hosting our birthday parties. Tyler Cintron is owner and operator.

Art Birthday Parties

If the young artist in your family is celebrating a birthday, the Brush & Palette is the perfect place to do it. Birthday parties for children ages five and older include art projects, pizza and an artist's cake. It's two hours of art and fun with everything included. Cost: \$200.00.

Workshops

Tallahassee has a number of working artists of national and international stature. While these artists may not be available to teach on an on-going basis, they are often willing to conduct workshops within the community. Artists such as Steve Andrews and Dean Gioia will be doing workshops here this fall. The Brush & Palette has offered a number of these one-and two-day workshops with local and regional artists and will continue to do so several times a year. Price and schedule vary and updated information will be provided on the B&P website.

ADULT ART CLASSES

OIL – Th., 10:00a.m. to 12:00 p.m., Wed., 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. \$55 per month.

This class meets once a week and students work individually on a subject of their choosing. Instructors Pam Talley and Charlotte Forehand work with students in the studio. All of our painting instructors are qualified to teach both oil and acrylic. Students provide their own materials and pre-registration is required.

Watercolor-beg.-adv. artists welcome – Monday 10:00a.m. to 12:00 p.m., \$55 per month This class meets once a week and students work individually on a subject of their choosing. Class begins Monday, September 10, 2012.

Handmade Collage Papers and Painting – Tuesday 10:00a.m. to 12:00 p.m., The class is \$108 for eight weeks. Using primarily acrylic paint, students will create multimedia collage art and paintings based on a subject or style of their choosing. Class begins Tuesday, September 11, 2012.

Color Projects Workshop Class – 10:00a.m. to 12:00 p.m., The class is \$108 for eight weeks, class begins Tuesday, January 8, 2013. Each class will feature projects to help students working in either watercolor or acrylic, while learning more about color and color relationships.

Composition- One of the most important elements in painting. It's how artists determine where to direct the observer's eye and coordinate all elements in the painting to produce a harmonious whole.

This fall, a well-known Russian artist Natalia Andreeva, will be teaching an 8-week course focusing on the principles of composition as well as on the other fundamental elements in art: shape, color, texture, value, and line. Class begins September 5th and is \$108 for eight weeks.

Wine Night Out- Beginning in October 2012, the Brush & Palette will host a series of workshops for adults. On the first Tuesday in each month from 7:00 to 9:00 pm the studio staff will offer a series of different projects. Projects will range from completing an oil painting to making a clock from scratch. Attendees may bring their favorite wine and snacks will be provided. Fees for the class will vary depending on what supplies each participant needs, but pre-registration is required. The schedule of projects and dates will be posted on the website.

YOUNG ARTIST CLASSES

Pre-School –A six-week class and is offered twice a year. The class is \$85 for six weeks and all materials are included. Two to four-year-olds work on open-ended projects that are process-based. If your pre-school child is creative and loves art, this is a perfect class. Fall class begins October 2, 2012 and Spring class begins February 5, 2013.

Mixed Media – 3:30 p.m.-4:30p.m. Tues. or Thurs., all materials included. Classes are \$55 per month/for a once a week class. Drawing, painting, sculpture and collage for students ages five to nine. Students work in a different media each week.

Drawing – Ages eight and older, 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Wed. or Thurs., students supply their own materials. Brush & Palette Supply Kit, \$39.95. Classes are \$55 per month/for a once a week class. This class is designed to enhance the student's drawing skills. The studio focuses on shape, shading and technique for drawing in pencil, pastel and watercolor.

Painting – Ages 10 and older, 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Wed. or Thurs., students supply their own materials. Brush & Palette Supply Kit, \$39.95. Classes are \$55 per month/for a once a week class. Instructors work with students individually in a studio setting. Students elect to work in oil, watercolor or acrylic. Each student works at his/her own pace on a subject they have selected.

Monthly Fees: \$55 per month







Please register at least one week in advance of the start of class.

Gilchrist Elementary School pickup, including supervision and snack: \$15 per month. Fees are due on the first day of the month. A late fee of \$10 will be added after the 10th of the month. Missed lessons can be made up within the same week as the missed class.

Once fees have been paid, there are NO REFUNDS.

All classes are subject to change or cancellation if enrollment minimums are not met.
