ADULT ART CLASSES/WORKSHOPS

Oil Painting-Wed. or Th., 10a.m.-12:00p.m. \$55 per month

This class meets once a week and students work individually on a subject of their choosing. Instructors Pam Talley and Charlotte Forehand are highly trained in both oil and acrylic and work with students in the studio. Students provide their own materials and are welcome to join the class at any time, call first to check availability.

Design for Watercolorist-Mon. or Tues. 10a.m.-12:00p.m. \$110 per eight weeks

(Mondays September 8 – October 27) or (Tuesdays September 9 – October 28)

In this class students, under the direction of instructor Nina Allen Freeman, will explore different lessons on design and composition. Open to watercolor and acrylic students, painting in any level, who want to refresh their knowledge about color and design.

Adult Drawing with Eluster-Wed. 10a.m.-12:00p.m. \$85 per six weeks (Sept.3-Oct 8)

The most fundamental component of art-drawing-will be offered beginning this fall, for eight weeks. Pencil, Oil Pastel and Charcoal techniques will be studied. This course was designed to focus the student's eye on the many facets of drawing including perspective, light and shadow and tromp l'oeil.

Portraits with Eluster-Wed. 10a.m.-12:00p.m. \$85 per six weeks (Oct.15-Nov 19)

This class meets once a week, for six weeks. Instructor Eluster Richardson who is highly trained in both oils and watercolor will guide students through the portrait painting process. Students provide their own materials, space is limited so reserve your spot today.
